

## Affordable Community Program (ACP) Financial Aid Income Requirements

Students and Families are eligible for the ACP if your income is **200% or less** than the Federal Poverty Guidelines (see the table below). The guideline is based on your household size and state. The table below reflects the income limit by household size, which is 200% of the 2022 Federal Poverty Guidelines.

For each additional person, add:	\$9,440	\$11,800	\$10,860

You may have to show proof of income, like a tax return or three consecutive pays stubs, when you apply for the ACP.
